- 5. Search and input b-roll
- 6. Obtain permissions for b-roll
- 7. Ensure logical sequencing and smooth running
- 8. Consult with stakeholders from production to post-production process to prepare the final outputs
- 9. Being able to collaborate with the CEO in developing an artistic vision for a television program and then producing it
- 10. To edit short videos for ads, trailers and/or other promo content social media
- 11. Able to work within a small budget allocated for b-roll, while still meeting quality and creative goals.
- 12. To continuously discover and implement new editing processes and technology and to maximize efficiency and share the story line in a compelling way.

Requirements:
