BACK ON THE ROAD

- FILMING FAITH AND HISTORY IN THE HOLY LAND

We are back on the road again, filming some brand-new television programs for The Incredible Journey. There is nothing quite like Bible stories to inspire and uplift us.

We are presently on our way to Jerusalem to film some of the grand stories of the Old Testament, including the

story of King Hezekiah, one of Judah's greatest kings. Hezekiah had a close relationship with God and did "what was right and faithful before the Lord his God" 2 Chronicles 31:20.

One of the highlights of a visit to Jerusalem is seeing and exploring Hezekiah's Tunnel. This ancient waterway stands as a testament to the biblical story and is a marvel of both history and archaeology.

It is an ancient water tunnel, built in the late 8th century BC by King Hezekiah to secure the city's water supply during an anticipated Assyrian siege. It is a 533-meter or 1,750-foot-long aqueduct that channels water from the Gihon Spring, located outside the city walls, to the Pool of Siloam, situated within the city walls. Hezekiah's tunnel is known as a remarkable engineering feat. Two teams of workers dug from opposite ends of the rock tunnel and unbelievably met in the middle. No one is sure how it was done; some think they were possibly guided by sound signals echoing through the limestone.

Our cameras will capture the story of King Hezekiah and this extraordinary feat of ancient engineering, showing how a king's faith and ingenuity saved his people.





We are also filming a series focused on the life of Joshua, born into slavery in Egypt, part of the Exodus, one of the spies of Israel sent by Moses to explore the land of Canaan. After the death of Moses, he led the Israelite tribes in the conquest of Canaan, including the fall of Jericho.

The story unfolds after Moses' death, with Joshua leading the Israelites across the Jordan River into the Promised Land. Their first obstacle, the fortified city of Jericho, with its massive walls, must have seemed impenetrable to a nomadic people carrying no siege equipment.

God's instructions to Joshua must have seemed bizarre. March around the city once a day for six days in complete silence, with priests carrying the Ark of the Covenant. On the seventh day, circle seven times, then have the priests blow their trumpets and the people shout. The walls collapse in perhaps one of the most dramatic moments in Biblical history.

We will re-enact Joshua's speech before the battle, his charge to the soldiers, the city of Jericho taken, and Rahab the prostitute and her family spared because she'd hidden the Israelite spies. Every detail of the story matters because this story is about faith overcoming impossible odds.

Archaeologists have found evidence of the ancient fortifications of Jericho. The Jericho walls were real, just as Scripture tells it, and it's a story that has inspired millions to believe that God can bring down any wall standing between them and their destiny.

The story of Joshua, the battle of Jericho and the battle of Al, are just one of ten new television programs we are filming. From Elijah's epic battle against King Ahab and Queen Jezebel, to the the Upper Room and how the apostles died, and the unbelievable story of Cyrus, whose reigh Isaiah predicted about 150 years before his birth.

We are bringing Scripture to life with cinematic power and historical respect. We are capturing something wonderful, they're visual sermons, historical documentaries, and artistic expressions of faith.

The cameras will roll. The stories will unfold. And it is our hope that somewhere, a viewer will watch these Bible stories, watch Joshua's walls fall and remember that faith can accomplish what seems impossible!







That's why we're on the road again, to tell these stories that have inspired humanity for thousands of years, and to show that the places, people, and events of Scripture remain as powerful today as when they were first recorded.

And so, the journey continues for us all as we race towards the end of 2025 and the beginning of 2026. I would like to take this opportunity to wish all our Incredible Journey family and friends a safe and happy festive season and God's richest blessing for the new year ahead.

Partnership with The Incredible Journey remains a crucial source of funding and an auspicious opportunity to promote the ministry. However, we often find that loyal TIJ supporters are unable to travel to the Gold Coast due to circumstances, such as scheduling, age, or health. As such, we have reflected on the various ways we can connect with our supporters throughout the year, and we have decided to do local TIJ events, which we call "Lunch with Gary". These events offer an opportunity to invite friends and family to enjoy a vegetarian meal, dessert, and refreshments while enjoying uplifting music and learning more about TIJ, its current impact, and plans for the future. We hope that guests are encouraged by the report they receive and ask that our loyal supporters invite their friends to these events. We also hope that they will consider supporting TIJ.

In 2023, we hosted our first additional event since the pandemic era at the newly revamped 7 at Avondale on the Avondale University campus. On April 13, we held our very first Melbourne Lunch with Gary fundraiser—a joyful milestone that brought new friends, warm fellowship, and a spirit of gratitude. Later in the year, we returned to Avondale on October 12 for our third gathering there, followed by our second Sydney event on October 17.

Across these events, Gary Kent shared inspiring insights into our ministry's journey, mission and achievements, reminding us again how God works through every season—often in ways that surprise and bless us. Local musicians, Janelle Bocala and friends, Cybele Craig, and the Talanoa Family, lifted hearts and created an atmosphere of praise and gratitude at each event.

RIGHT AROUND AUSTRALIA



The Bubsie RAA Team has now been on the road for nine months. It has been an amazing journey as we have touched base with many people over that time and had the opportunity to share the story of Nevill and Greg as they journeyed around Australia 100 years ago, bringing hope and the gospel to outback communities. With over 320 events completed, there are many stories of interactions that we could share, but here are just a few snippets from our journey.

REGIONAL VICTORIA – We visited a small town early in

our journey. A church plant is being established there, and the local church members joined with a group of ladies from a couple of the churches in town to put on an event at the local Uniting Church. We had visits from the mayor, city councillors, and others as they stopped by to see Bubsie. Kevin shared the story with the group of people who were there. Our local representative in the town recently shared with us that, following our visit, a couple of people are now attending the church plant, and another has recently been baptised. The members are continuing to share in their community and are excited about the responses they are finding. The Uniting Church has also asked our local representative to preach for them once a month, as they have increased confidence in the message of salvation that we share.

NARELLAN SHOPPING CENTRE DISPLAY – The Campbelltown church organised an event in the Narellan Shopping Centre on a Sunday. Their team joined the RAA team in interacting with the people as they came through the centre. We connected with over 1,000 people and gave out over 500 books. They had all their team in black uniform t-shirts with the Right Around Australia logo, and the excitement of those taking part increased during the day as they found how easy it was to engage and share the Overlander book with the public. They also included an advertising brochure in the book for their upcoming Prophetica event, which was scheduled for





a week later, and provided an opportunity for people to register online. Pr Boriss Soldat reported that the following week, they had a full house at their church hall for the Prophetica seminar, where Pr Gary Webster and Boriss shared in the presentations. Following the Prophetica, 49 people signed up to continue with the Secrets of Prophecy series, most of whom are from the community.

CANBERRA MUSEUM - The museum had contacted the office asking that we please not tell people to ask for Bubsie to be on display, as they were being inundated with requests to see the original Bubsie. While we had not specifically told people to do that, we do mention that the original Bubsie is the property of the museum. However, we recently were told by a visitor to the museum for an event that was being held there, that one of the staff had spoken to them and asked if they were connected at all to the sponsors of the Right Around Australia journey and had then related that she had so many people asking about Bubsie that she decided to do her own research on the story and in so doing had been impressed by the commitment of these two young men and had decided to become a Christian.

UNEXPECTED RESULTS - We are sometimes surprised at what God does with the little and unexpected. In Wangaratta, one of our events was disrupted because the location had been dug up for renovations, and the council was unaware of the planned work at the time the event was booked. As a result, they suggested we go across the river to a park instead. We did that, but there was little foot traffic, and no one was expecting us there, so we probably only spoke to about three people. However, one of those people happened to be a young man who was filming a social media blog and asked if he could include a bit in his blog. The 10-second clip was recorded, and we didn't really think much









more about it. However, the following day in Benalla, a young lady passed by our display and excitedly exclaimed that she had seen Bubsie on Instagram the day before and was thrilled to think she had now seen it in person. More than 9,000 people had viewed that blog.

BUBSIE'S RECORDS – Our day in Benalla started with a couple of laps of the Winton Motor Raceway. Once again, Bubsie made a couple of records:

- 1. The oldest car (1923 Citroen 5CV) to have gone around the Raceway
- 2. The fastest time for a car under 10 horsepower to have done a lap: 4 minutes 41.75 seconds

Every day, we see God at work, orchestrating events and circumstances, providing us with protection on the road and in the weather. We know this is His journey, and we are privileged to be in partnership with Him, knowing that He is faithful in all He does. We praise Him for providing trailer repair workshops within 2 km of where our wheel came off the caravan, for Woolworths permitting us to display under their verandah when the rain was expected, and for divine appointments with people that we talk with, knowing that only God could have orchestrated our meeting. We are always extremely thankful for the generous support of donors who have funded this journey as we see people impacted by the power of the gospel story.

Our team is currently working on a comprehensive series of 14 programs on the Bible book of Daniel. Each episode is dedicated to exploring one chapter of Daniel in depth, unpacking its historical context, prophetic message, and spiritual relevance. The series also includes a special introductory program to set the foundation and a final concluding program that brings together the major themes and insights uncovered throughout the book.

Developed in partnership with Hope Channel Germany, this project weaves in carefully researched archaeological evidence that supports the accuracy and reliability of the prophecies found in Daniel. From ancient inscriptions to significant historical artifacts, each discovery helps illuminate the world in which Daniel lived and strengthens confidence in the authenticity of its remarkable predictions.

We are excited about this project and hope to release the full series in 2026. The programs will also have accompanying resources to help viewers study, share, and explore the book of Daniel more deeply.



This program explores King Nebuchadnezzar's dream in Daniel 2, a prophecy that outlines world history, explains why leaders like Charlemagne, Charles V, Louis XIV, Napoleon, Kaiser and Hitler all failed to unite Europe, and reveals what is still to come.



On 28 November 1979, Air New Zealand Flight TE901 crashed into Mt Erebus, killing all 257 on board in New Zealand's worst civil disaster. In this program, we retrace the flight and uncover the complex story behind the tragedy, searching for answers and lessons that must never be forgotten.



British philosopher Antony Flew was a leading atheist for over 50 years, challenging the existence of God in universities worldwide. Later in life, he rejected atheism and became a believer. What made him change his mind?



This program explores the stories of children burdened by their fathers' crimes, some too young to understand, others born after the war, inviting us to reflect on the legacies we inherit and leave behind
